Thank you very much for your interest in volunteering with Operation Red Nose. We're sure you'll enjoy the experience and be satisfied knowing that not only are you making the roads safer and potentially saving a life, you're also helping to raise money for KidSport! Our process has changed a bit this year, so please read carefully.

Our Volunteer Coordinator will be processing over 250 of these, so in order to volunteer, please complete both pages of our application form **completely and clearly**. On the application, please ensure you also circle the nights that you would like to commit to volunteering. You can always add more later. The nights of operation are **Dec 1**, **2**, **8**, **9**, **15**, **16**, **22** and **31**. If you did a PIC last year you will not need a new PIC this year. All PIC's are good for 3 years. If you are volunteering for the first time either since 2019 or the very first time you will need to do PIC.

If you are a new volunteer, we will need you to have a PIC done as early as possible before you volunteer. To do so, please visit any of the Burnaby RCMP Police Offices:

You'll need two pieces of government issued ID. Accepted ID:

- Valid driver's license with photo
- Valid BC identification card with photo
- Current Canadian passport (expired passports not accepted)
- Birth certificate
- Immigration documents
- Certificate of Indian Status
- Canadian citizenship card
- Permanent resident card

Please give them the attached letter (so that you don't have to pay) along with your record check form that you will get from the RCMP. Wait for your check to be processed and when finished forward your application (both pages) and PIC to us. Either scan or take a quality picture of them and email them to us at <a href="mailto:tricitiesorn@gmail.com">tricitiesorn@gmail.com</a> Please try to do this as early as possible, because it can take up to a week for your application to get to us.

# DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

For office duties, please contact your local Operation Red Nose organization.

**Escort driver** 

Person who escorts the driver and the navigator in his or her own vehicle.

Must be 19 years of age or older Must have a valid Class 5 driver's licence and a vehicle

- Please carefully complete the *Driver's Licence* and *Insurance Company* sections on the reverse.
- Operation Red Nose only provides insurance coverage to escort drivers whose vehicles are insured against damage.
- You must carry your proof of insurance and your driver's licence with you on the night of your shift with Operation Red Nose.

Driver

Person who drives the client's vehicle.

Must be 21 years of age or older Must have a valid Class 5 driver's licence

- Please indicate your driver's licence file number on the reverse.
- You must carry your driver's licence with you on the night of your shift with Operation Red Nose.

Navigator

Person who rides with the driver in the client's vehicle.

Must be 19 years of age or older Driver's licence not mandatory.

 but indicating the number on the reverse will speed up the processing of your application.

**Driving:** flight, dangerous operation of a motor vehicule, refusal to comply with demand, operation while impaired

(accepted as a navigator during prohibition), unpaid tickets

(tickets must be paid before volunteering)
